Another Wednesday afternoon/evening option ...



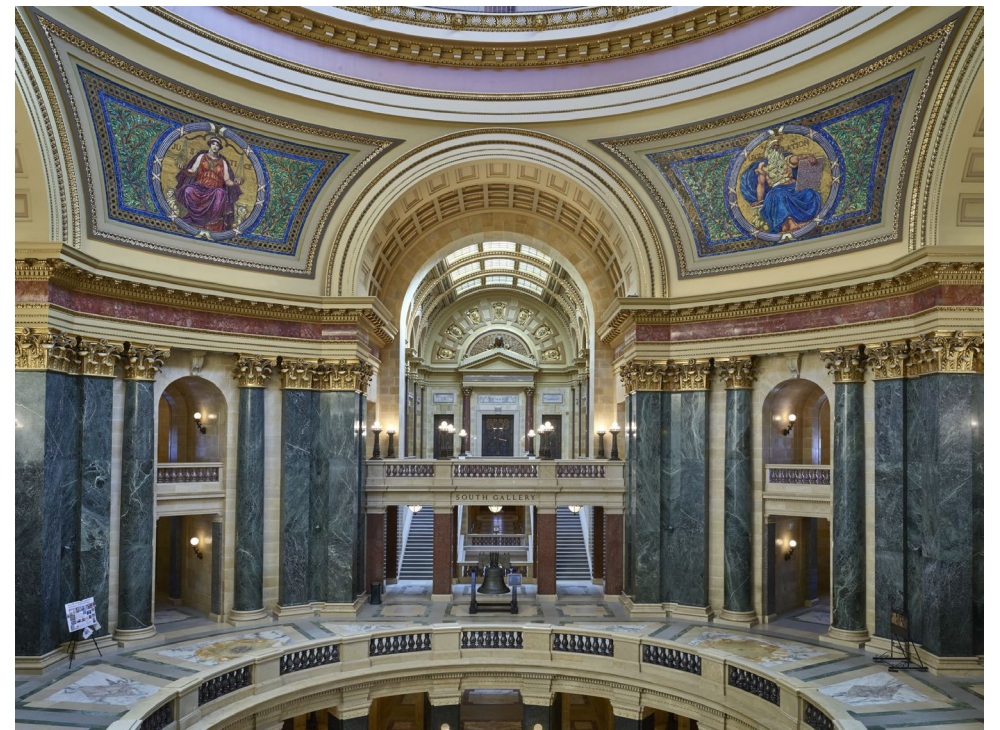
Some anniversaries come and go unnoticed. That's not the way UW–Madison rolls.
