



Carbon Cycle and Climate Modeling Teacher Workshop

July 14th, 15th, & 16th 2009



When: Tuesday & Wednesday from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm & Thursday from 8:30 am to noon.

Where: Atmospheric, Oceanic and Space Science building, UW-Madison campus.

Compensation: Lunches, overnight lodging for educators from outside of Dane County, and \$100.00 tuition-offset stipends for educators opting to earn college credit.

Cost: \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee for all participants.

Changes to the Earth's climate are being driven by human modification to the global carbon cycle. This workshop will provide an overview of climate mechanisms and global climate change, with a particular focus on the carbon cycle. Expert presentations, group discussions and interactive computer training, including classroom applications of the EdGCM (Educational Global Climate Model) will be central activities in this 2.5 day workshop. Participating teachers will develop the skills and knowledge necessary to incorporate carbon cycle and climate modeling tools into their classrooms while simultaneously deepening their overall comprehension of climate system science.

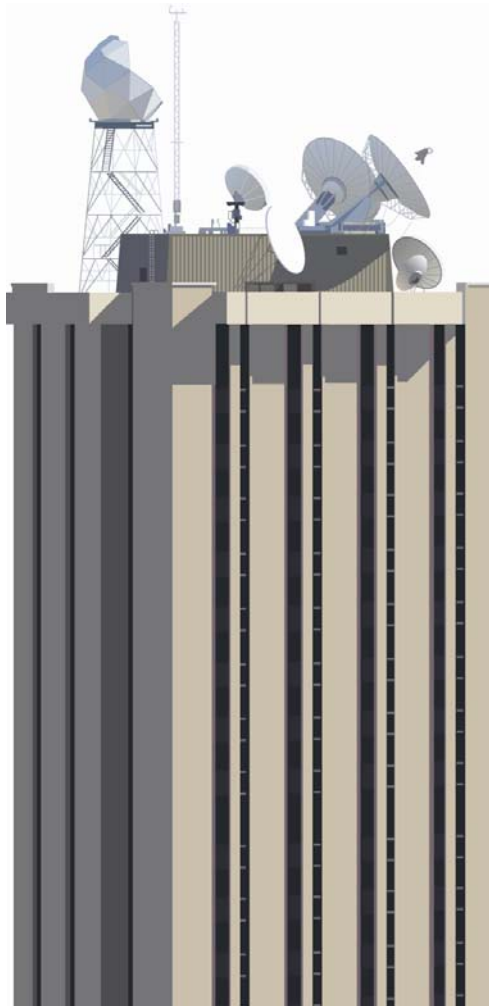
