The educator's workshop will start at 1pm Wednesday and end at 3pm Thursday and includes a poster session and community reception Wednesday evening. Educators are encouraged to stay overnight at Asilomar to maximize opportunities for interaction. Most workshop sessions will be focused on using Earth Science data to inform instruction: linking real-world scientific data to science curriculum in grades 9-14, with an emphasis on analyzing and interpreting data.
